WHAT IS PRINCE2®?

PRINCE2® is an internationally recognised method for running projects of any type and size. Used in over 60 countries, it is widely accepted worldwide by a large group of organisations. PRINCE2® does not require any special software.

This course has been designed for both

- experienced Project Managers who wish to learn PRINCE2® and gain the accreditation
- those who have little experience in project management and wish to learn more about the subject

The course emphasis is on the *practical* application of PRINCE2® in the real world, but participants will also be prepared to gain PRINCE2® formal qualifications.

COURSE OUTLINE

Foundation Course

A summary of PRINCE® is sent before the course and participants should allow about 2 hours to work through this. The workshop consists of 2 day coverage of PRINCE2® concepts and detail. The third day is revision and some new material. Day 3 ends with the one hour closed book Foundation exam. Participants should allow about two hours each evening for revision.

Practitioner Course

Course participants will be mailed substantial pre-reading materials and should allow for about 10-20 hours self study before the course. The two day course consist of

- 1½ days working through the syllabus topics and a sample paper
- The three hour open book exam

Participants should allow 2 hours in the evening of the first day for revision

Combined Foundation and Practitioner Course

As above but in 5 consecutive days. Participants should allow two hours each evening for revision. Participants will be sent both sets of pre-reading before the course and should allow 10-20 hours to work through this. This is an intensive course in PRINCE® but we have had high success rates with this approach.

Course Presentation

- The prepared material is presented in a way to encourage discussion and dialogue.
- The focus is on practical application in the workplace.
- A sample project is documented as part of the course materials.
- There are practical exercises on the first two days.
- Sample exam questions are provided and discussed throughout the course.

Participants are encouraged to talk about real projects and the exercises are taken from projects contributed by the class.
